Any teacher, staff member, parent or student can submit a Katy Parents of Gifted and Talented Grant request.

Some of the questions that the grant committee will consider in deciding which projects are funded are:

- Will this project solve an existing problem or meet a need that is not currently being met?
- Is there a clear idea of how the project would work? (Timetable, details, expenses.)
- Does the project meet the guidelines of our mission statement and the GT curriculum?
- Is this something that the school district should be providing to the gifted and talented students of the Katy Independent School District?
- How many students will benefit from this project?

If you are interested in applying for a grant for the 2007-2008 school year, please fill out the application and submit it by one of the deadlines. All grants will be considered at the KPGT Board meeting immediately following each deadline. All applicants will be notified within 30 days of submission.

Grant Application Instructions:

Cover Page must include only the following:

- Project Title
- Applicant Name
- Contact Phone Number
- Contact Email
- School
- Which students the project will benefit
- Dollar Amount Requested

Please attach the following:

- Description of the project
- Outline of projected expenses
- Timetable for the project
- Description of how this project will benefit gifted and talented students in KISD
- Estimated number of students that will benefit from this project

Details:

- If the project is selected for funding by the KPGT Grant Committee, grant recipients may request that KPGT write checks directly to vendors for grant related expenses, or the recipient may be reimbursed for expenses upon submission of receipts.
- KPGT requires a report from each grant recipient, describing how the funds were used, before the end of the school year in which the funds were used. The report may be in written form or presented verbally at a KPGT Campus Liaison meeting.
- Grant deadlines for the 2007-2008 school year are: September 23, 2007, December 23, 2007 & March 23, 2008. Grant requests received after a deadline will be reviewed after the next deadline.
